"Indeed the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart... 'You are lacking in one thing. Go sell what you have, and give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven, then come, follow me.'"

We call these reflections 'His Word Today' asking that what we read and hear, might have an effect upon us here and now. Surely, the teaching of Hebrew about the word and the question posed by the young man are familiar.

The former might lead me to ask if the word is truly alive, does it make a difference, does it really touch my heart, does that word lead me to a real encounter with Jesus?

The encounter of the one who met Jesus, could be the question I raise. I know the word and I try to put it into practice. I ask myself, what's the one thing I am lacking? Surely there is something I can or must do. I don't need to wait for Jesus to tell me, I am aware of it because His word has touched my heart. Surely there is something I can give away to someone – money, kindness and concern, needed encouragement, and then, perhaps for the first time I can really say I am following Him.

May the word of God be truly alive and effective.

“Porque la Palabra de Dios es viva y eficaz, y más cortante que cualquier espada de doble filo: ella penetra hasta la raíz del alma y del espíritu, de las articulaciones y de la médula, y discierne los pensamientos y las intenciones del corazón... ‘Sólo te falta una cosa: ve, vende lo que tienes y dalo a los pobres; así tendrás un tesoro en el cielo. Después, ven y sígueme.’”

Llamamos a estas reflexiones ‘Su Palabra Hoy’, pidiendo que lo que leamos y escuchemos pueda tener efecto en nosotros aquí y ahora. Seguramente, la lección en la carta de los Hebreos acerca de la palabra y la pregunta hecha por el joven son familiares.

La primera me lleva a preguntar si la palabra está verdaderamente viva, hace una diferencia, si realmente toca mi corazón, si en verdad me lleva a un encuentro con Jesús.

El encuentro del joven con Jesús podría ser la pregunta que me hago. Conozco la palabra e intento ponerla en práctica. Me pregunto a mí mismo, ¿que es lo que me falta? Seguramente hay algo que puedo o debo hacer. No necesito esperar a que Jesús me lo diga, ya que me doy cuenta yo mismo pues Su palabra ha tocado mi corazón. Seguramente hay algo que puedo dar a alguien: dinero, amabilidad, consideración, apoyo, y luego, quizá por primera vez pueda yo decir que lo sigo.

Que la palabra de Dios esté verdaderamente viva y que sea eficaz.
